

**Resolution # 3262**

**2024 LIQUID FUELS APPLICATIONS**

WHEREAS, the Warren Board of Commissioners wishes to allocate to local municipalities monies from the County Liquid Fuel Tax Funds (hereinafter "LFT Funds") for the year 2024, scheduled for disbursement is a total amount of \$134,182.00; \$130,000 liquid fuels and \$4,182.00 bridge inspection reimbursement to municipalities;

WHEREAS, the local municipalities listed below are eligible for receipt of LFT Funds;

WHEREAS, the Commissioners have agreed to contribute to each local municipality the allocation set forth below subject to each local municipality making timely applications for LFT Funds and for payment;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Commissioners of Warren County, does hereby agree to contribute to each of the following local municipalities the allocation set forth hereinafter, subject to each municipality applying for its allocation of Liquid Fuel Funds by June 28, 2024, and completing its MS999 application for payment on or before November 30, 2024:


