

Resolution # 3263

A Resolution Authorizing Application to the Pennsylvania Historical and Museum Commission (PHMC) for Grant Funding

Whereas, the County of Warren, Pennsylvania recognizes the significance of preserving its historic landmarks for the benefit of the community and future generations; and

Whereas, the Warren County Courthouse noted as a historic landmark in the City of Warren, PA, has sustained damage to its main courtroom ceiling due to water infiltration, threatening its structural integrity and historical significance; and

Whereas, the proposed project entails the repair and restoration of the main courtroom ceiling in accordance with the preservation standards set forth by the Secretary of the Interior, as overseen by the architectural firm Larson and Karle; and

Whereas, the Pennsylvania Historical and Museum Commission (PHMC) offers grant funding opportunities to support projects focused on historic preservation and conservation efforts within the Commonwealth;

Whereas, the total estimated cost of the project is \$127,420.00, with the County of Warren committing to match the grant funding of \$63,710.00 provided by the PHMC, ensuring the successful completion of the restoration project;

Now, therefore, be it resolved by the Board of Commissioners of Warren County, Pennsylvania, that:

1. The County of Warren hereby authorizes and directs its representatives to submit an application to the Pennsylvania Historical and Museum Commission (PHMC) for grant funding in the amount of \$47,100.00 to support the restoration of the main courtroom ceiling at the Warren County Courthouse.

The County of Warren agrees to provide matching funds in the amount of \$63,710.00, bringing the total project budget to \$127,420.00.

The County of Warren affirms its commitment to working with the architectural firm Larson and Karle to ensure that all restoration work complies with the preservation standards of the Secretary of the Interior.

The County of Warren expresses its appreciation to the Pennsylvania Historical and Museum Commission for its support of historic preservation efforts in Warren County.


