WHEREAS, the Public Safety Telecommunicator of the Warren County Communications Center has contributed substantially to the apprehension of criminals, suppression of fires, and treatment of patients; and

WHEREAS, each dispatcher has exhibited compassion, understanding, and professionalism during the performance of their job in the past year;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the County of Warren, Pennsylvania declare the week of April 14-20, 2024 to be National Telecommunicator Week in Warren County, in honor of the men and women whose diligence and professionalism keep our county and citizens safe.


